Session for Language Center Coordinators: please present a document that proves that the person who participates coordinates a Language Center in order to register. Fill out the form previously. There will be two afternoon work sessions lasting 120 minutes.

Workshops: sessions that include active participation of the audience through discussion and completion of tasks assigned by the instructor / facilitator. Sessions should last 120 minutes.

Presentation of books: please register works published with a maximum of five years prior to the date of the Congress. 20 minutes + 10 minutes of Q&A.

SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS:

Submission of proposals, deadline for receiving proposals: March 01, 2022

A summary that meets the following specifications must be submitted:

- Be concise and clearly express the objective of the presentation, poster, panel, workshop or book presentation. It should contain between 300 and 500 words.
- It must be written in the language in which the presentation, panel or workshop is planned.
- It must be accompanied by bibliographic references or preliminary bibliography.
- The title must clearly state the main topic of the presentation, panel, workshop or book presentation and must not be more than two lines or fourteen words.
- All proposals must be unpublished.
- Abstracts should be sent through the following form: <https://bit.ly/2Zsnyq9>
- Abstracts must include a brief biodata of the speaker (maximum six lines)
- The Academic Committee will communicate the results of the selection of the proposals by email before February 28, 2022

Important note: Once the proposal is accepted, the speaker (s) must register for the event no later than March 15, 2022. If the speaker does not register for the event, the proposal will not be considered in the program.

FULL TEXT FOR CONGRESS' MEMOIRS

Deadline for full text submission: May 21, 2022.

The proposals accepted and presented at the event will be considered to be published in the congress memoirs (after a prior assessment process). For this purpose, the full text must be sent by email to: cial@enesmorelia.unam.mx

Manuscripts must meet the following specifications:

- The text must be 8 to 12 pages without pagination, Times New Roman, size 12.
- The title should be centered and in bold. The author's name must use the same font type and aligned to the right.
- Manuscripts must adhere to APA conventions for bibliographic references
- The first page must include the title, the author (s), a summary in Spanish and in the language of the text (between 50-100 words) and the key words in both languages.
